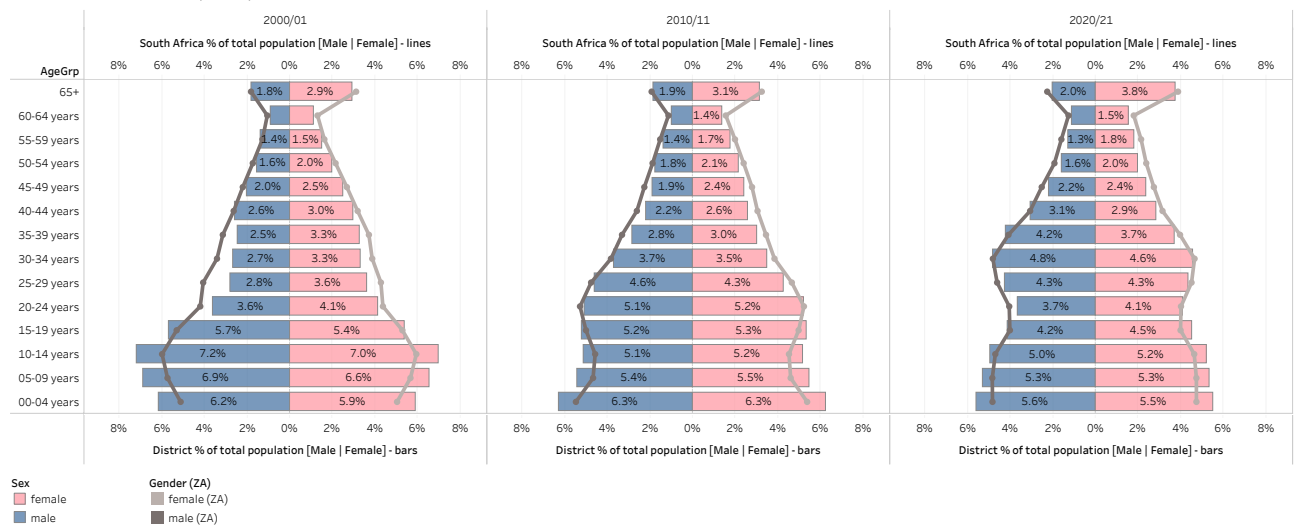

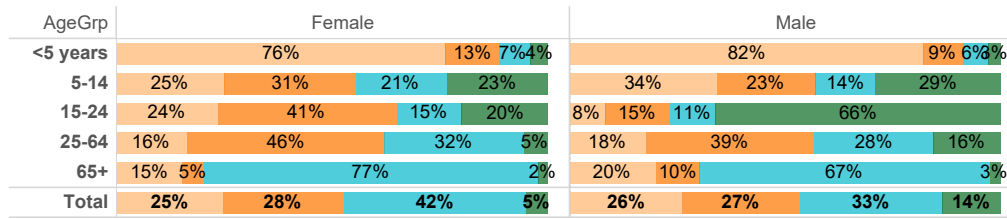

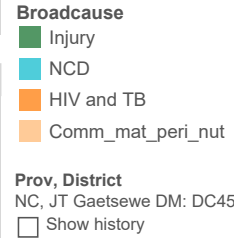

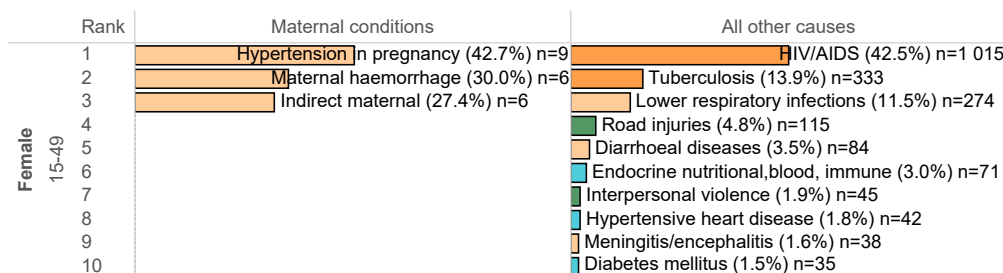
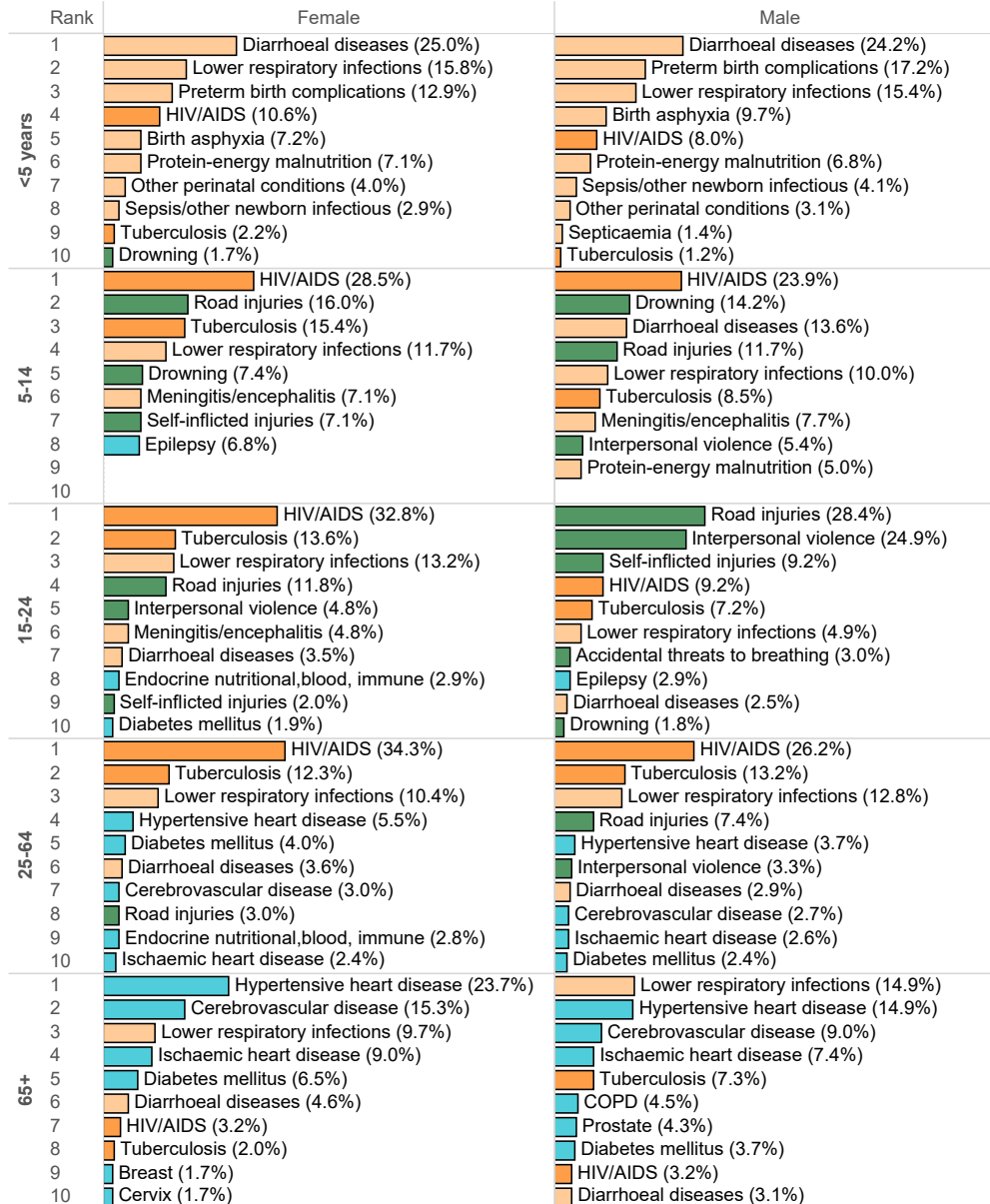
Percentage of deaths by broad cause and leading causes, 2012–2017

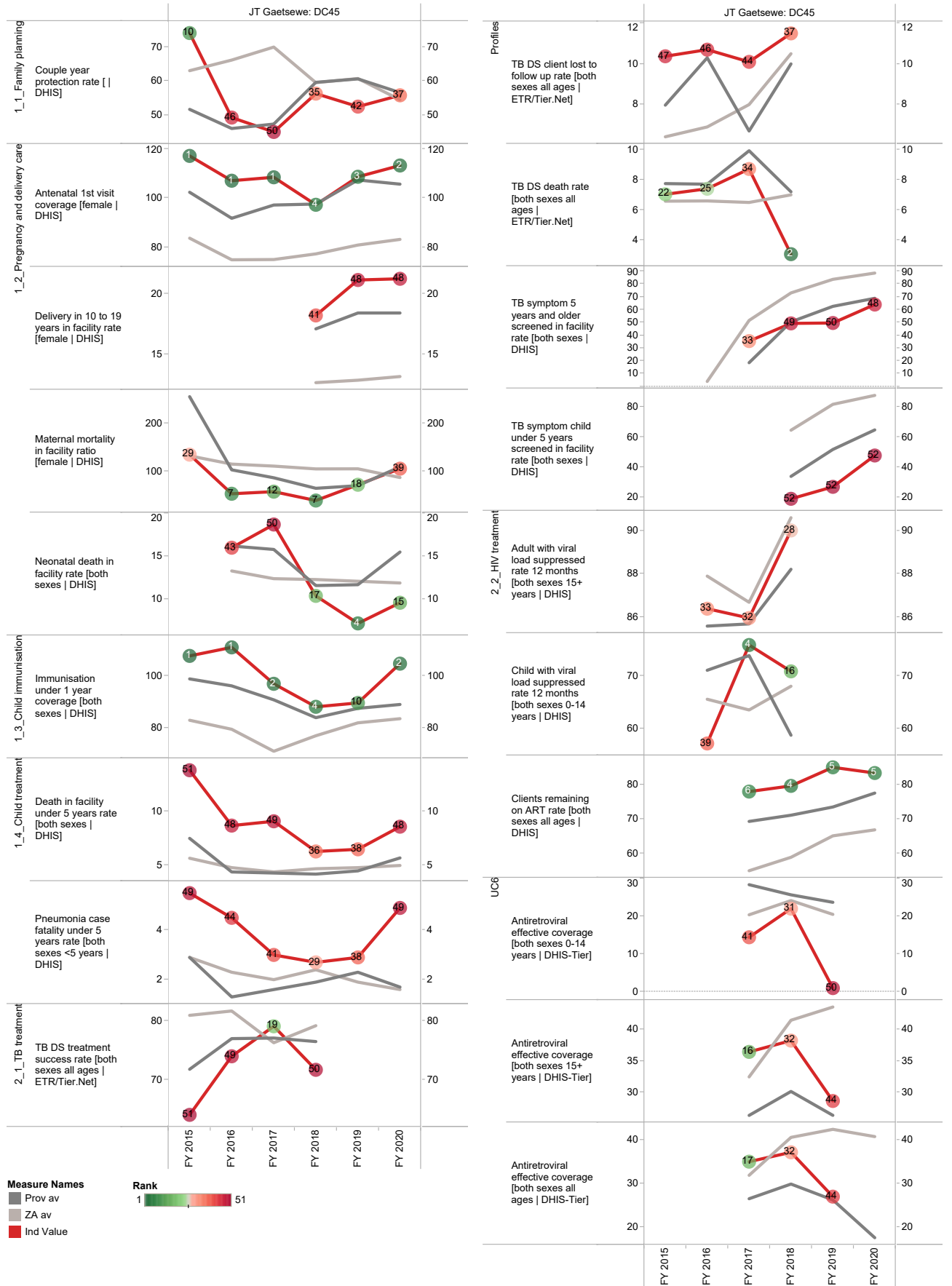
Percentage of deaths by broad causes and single leading causes



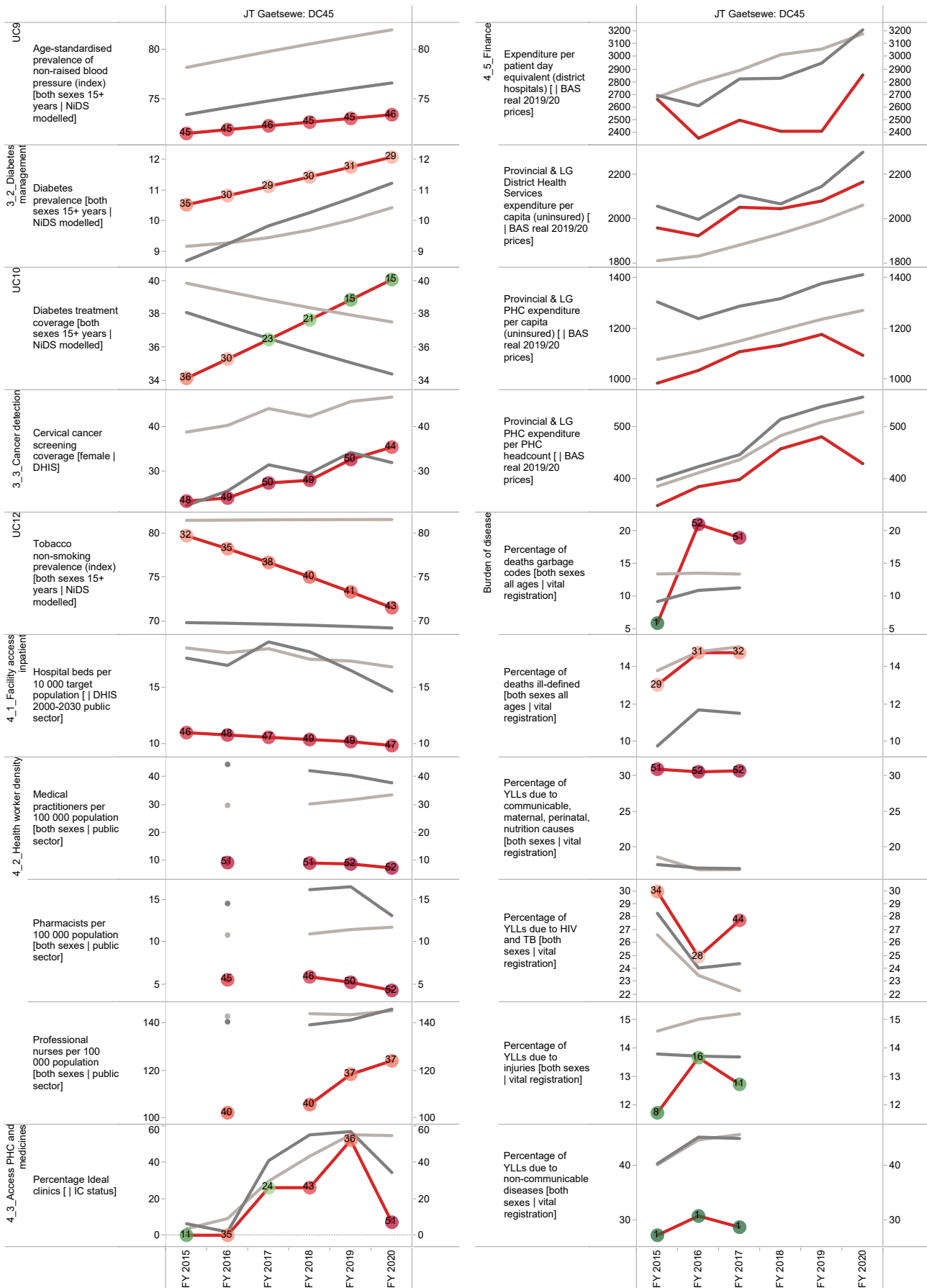

Namakwa District Municipality (DC6)

The Namakwa District Municipality^c is a Category C municipality located in the Northern Cape Province. It is bordered by the Republic of Namibia in the north and is the largest district in the province, making up over a third of its geographical area. It comprises six local municipalities: Nama Khoi, Hantam, Khai-Ma, Kamiesberg, Karoo Hoogland and Richtersveld.

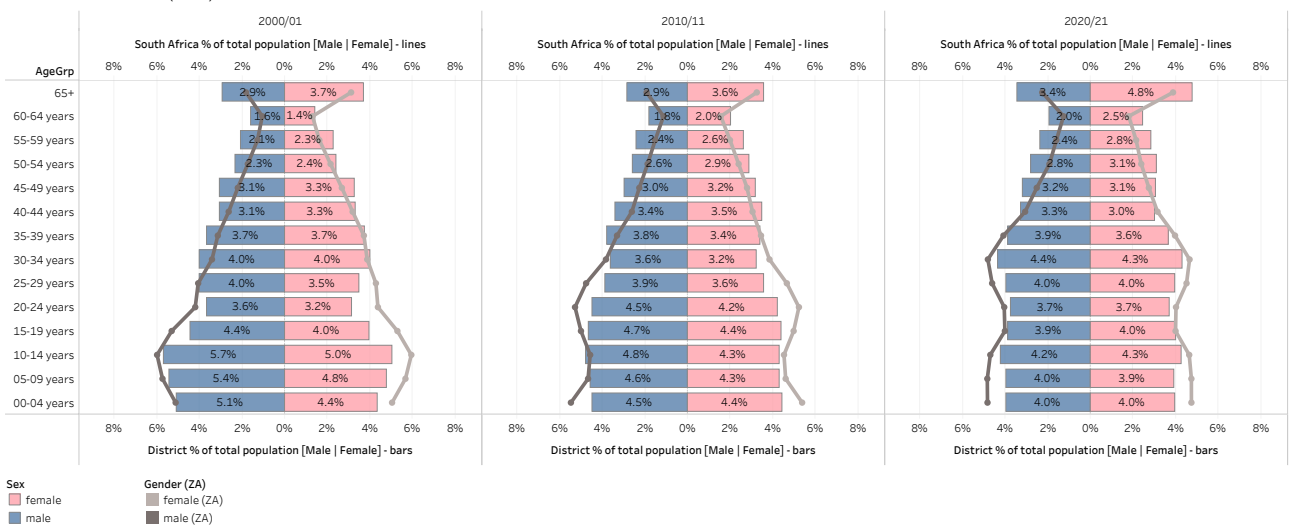

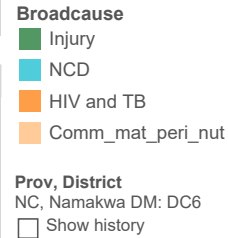

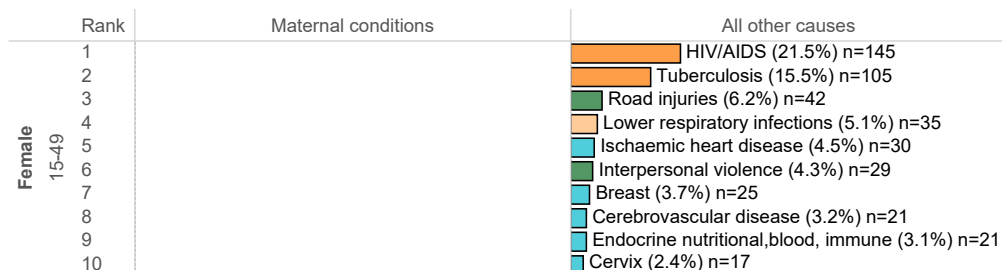

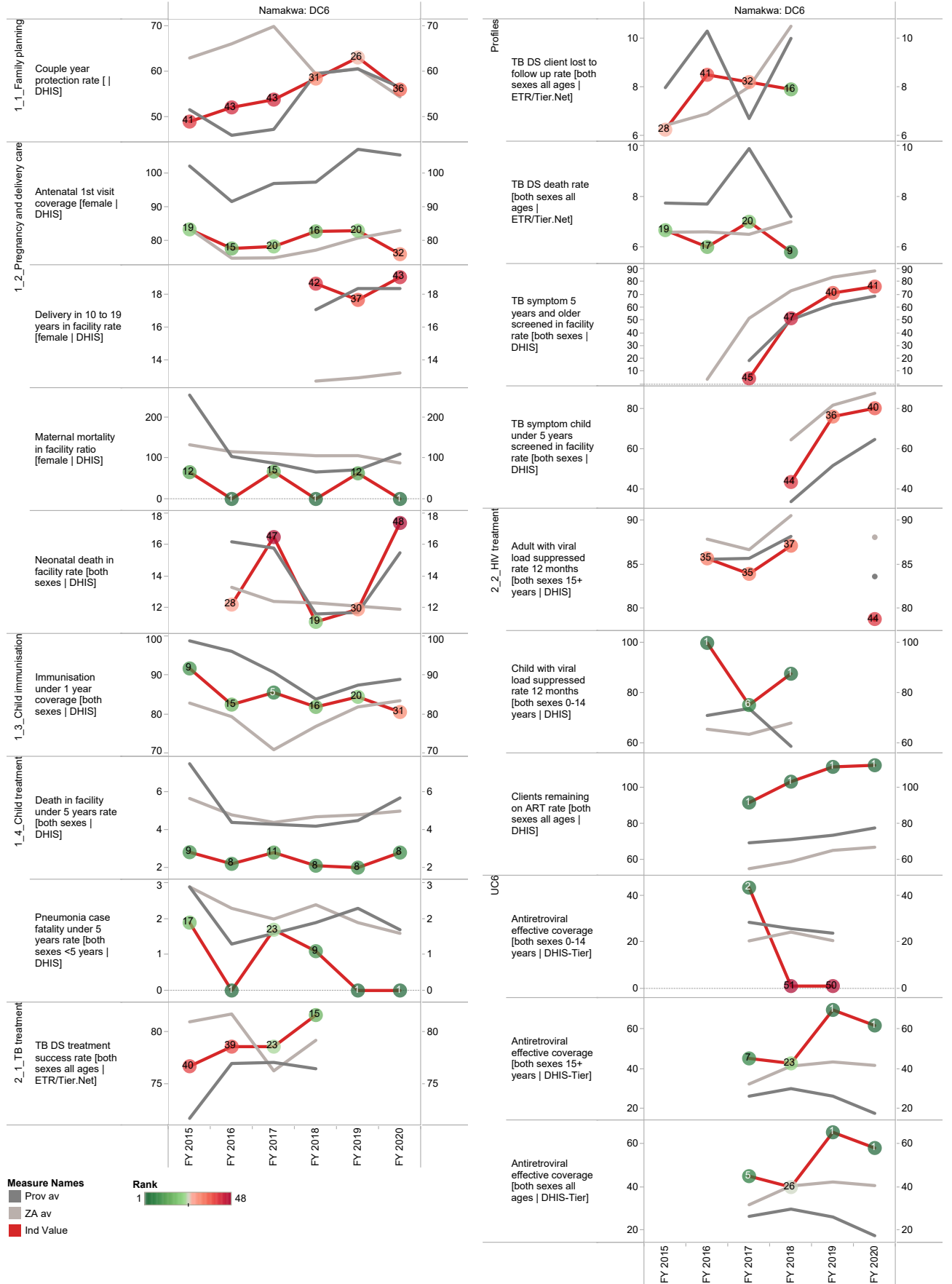
Percentage of deaths by broad causes and single leading causes



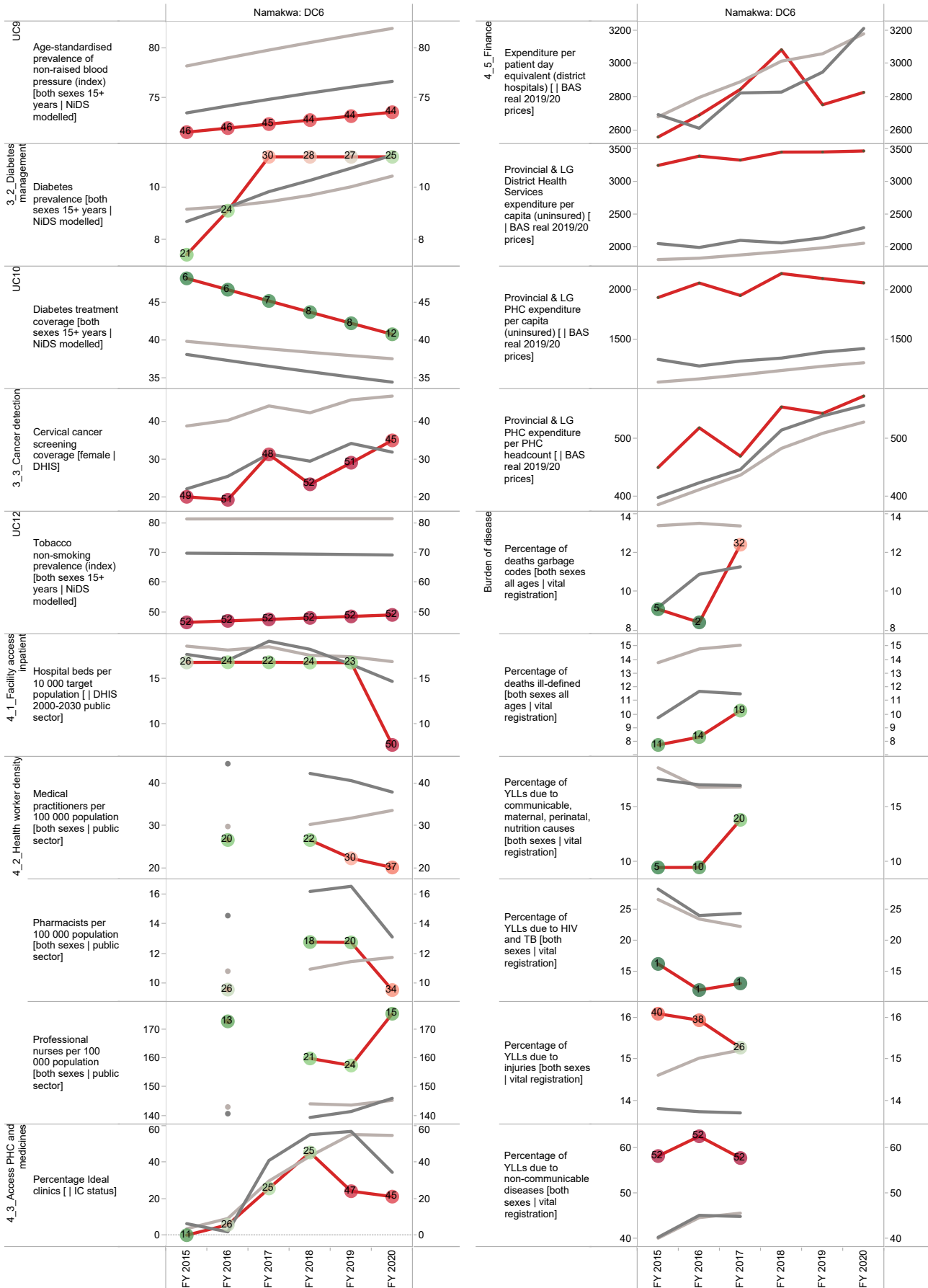

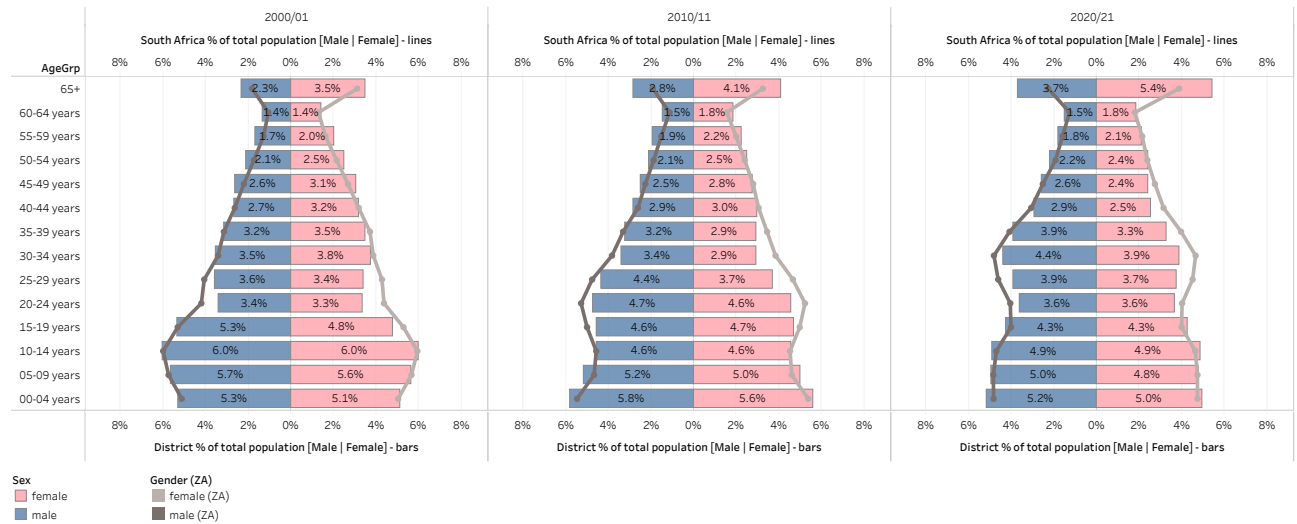

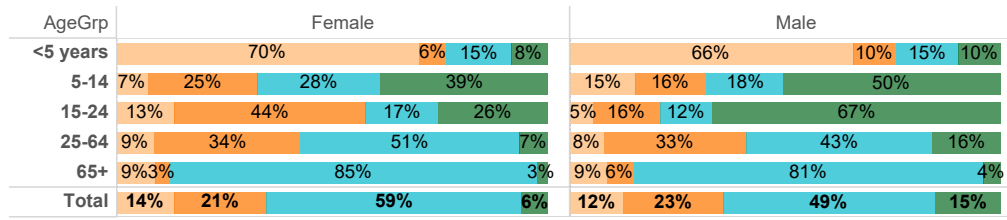

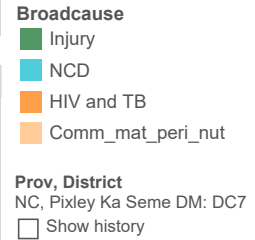

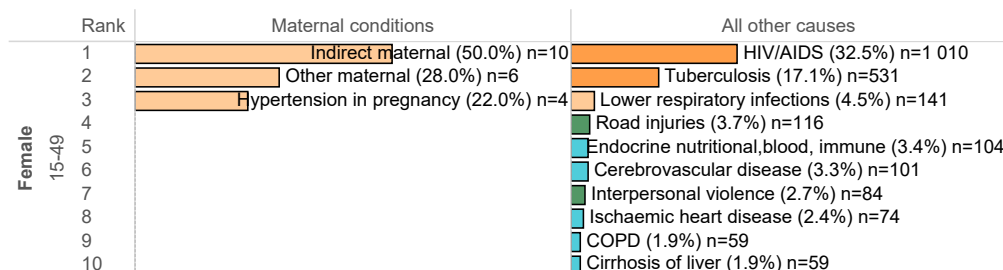
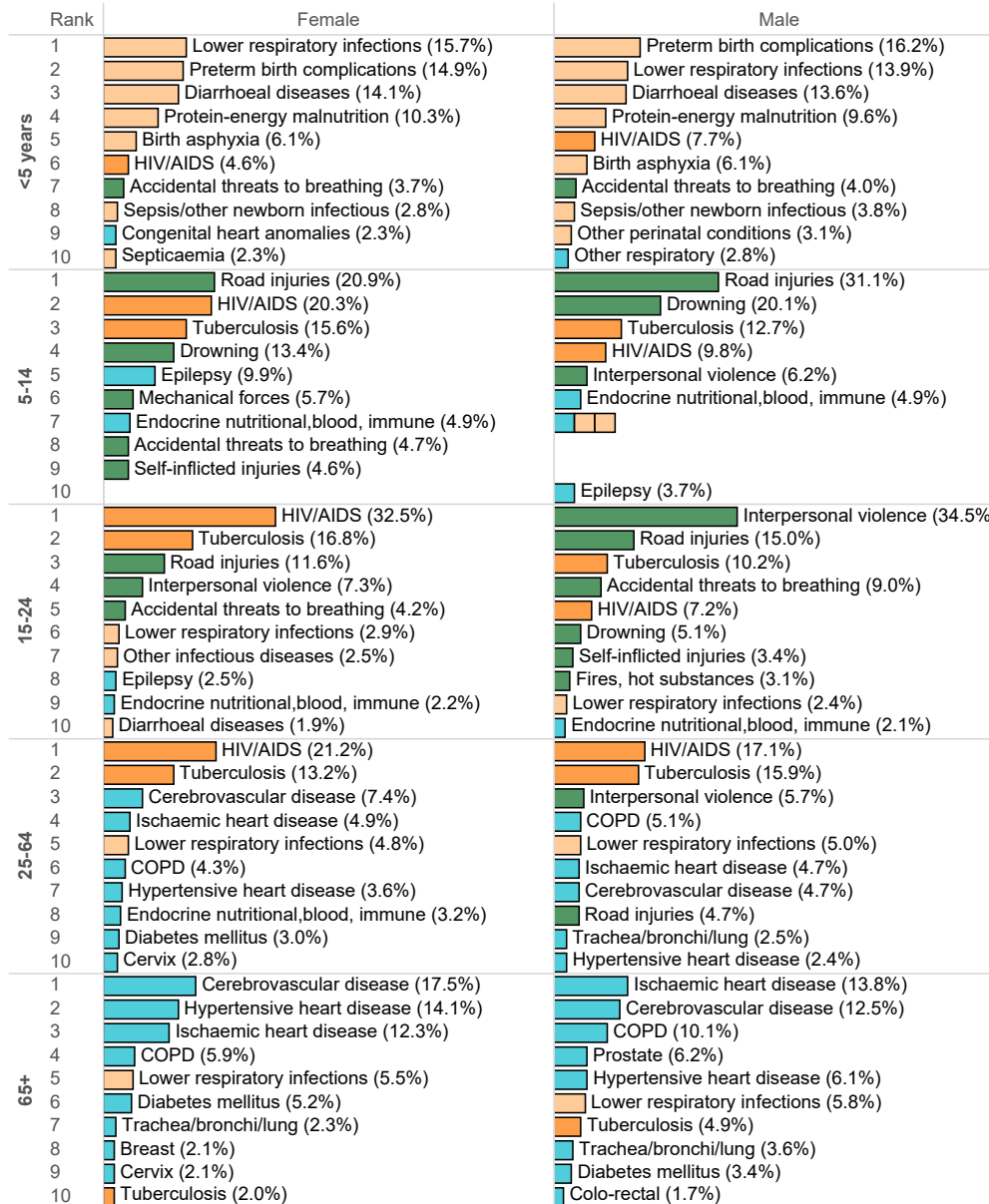
Percentage of deaths by broad cause and leading causes, 2012–2017
 NC, Pixley Ka Seme DM: DC7, 2012 - 2017



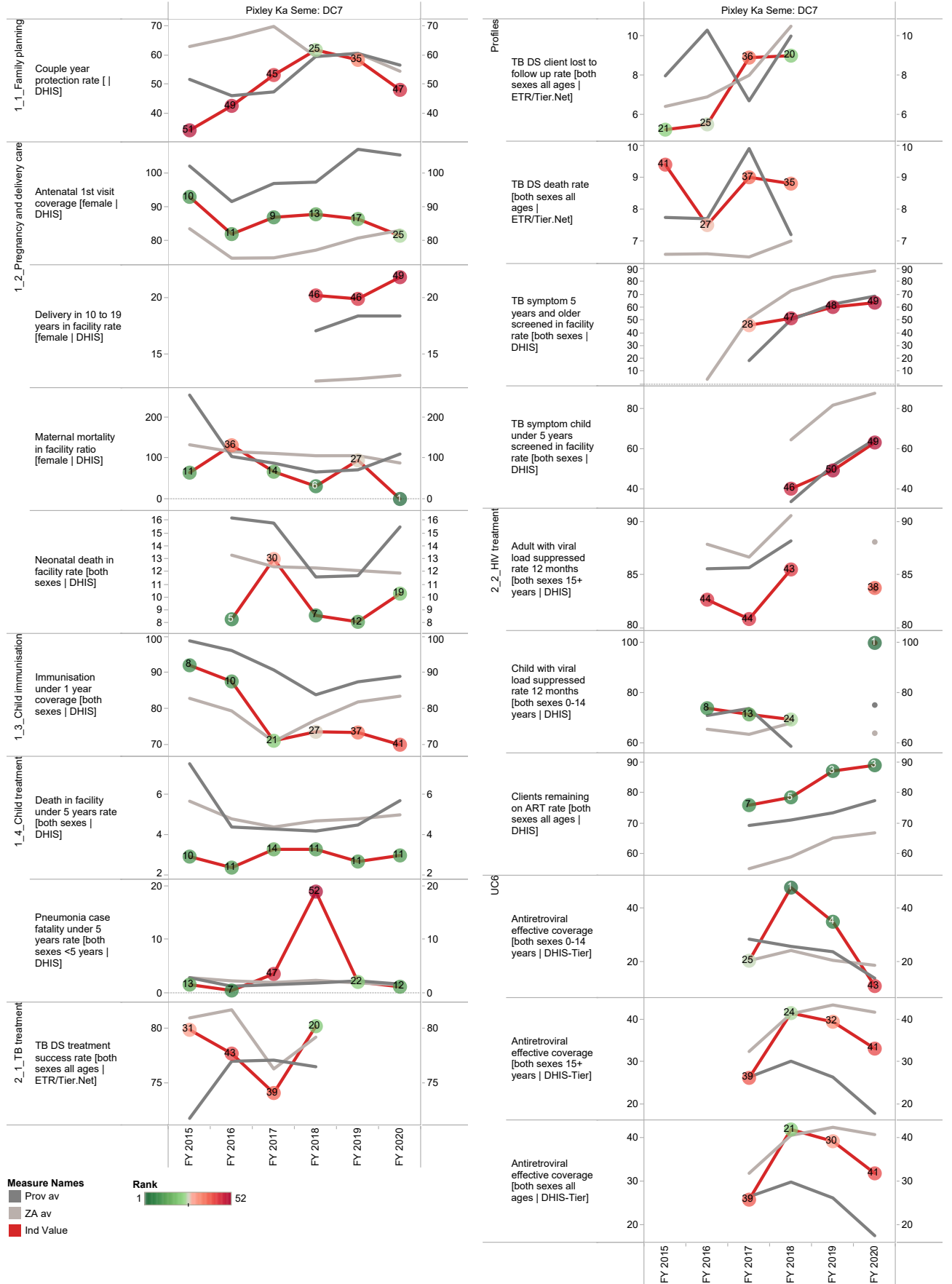
Percentage of deaths by broad causes and single leading causes



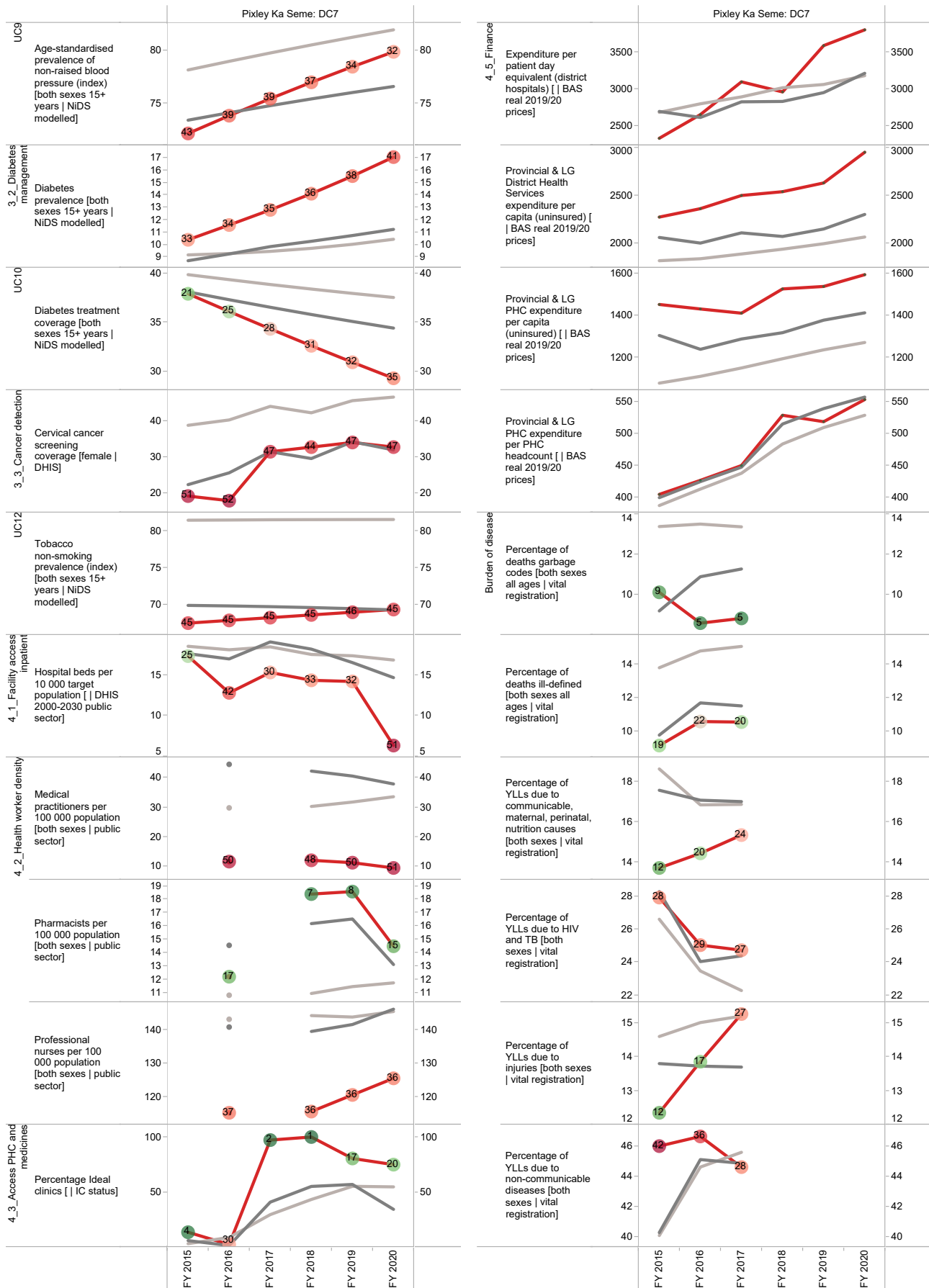

Upington is the district municipal capital, where the municipal government is located.

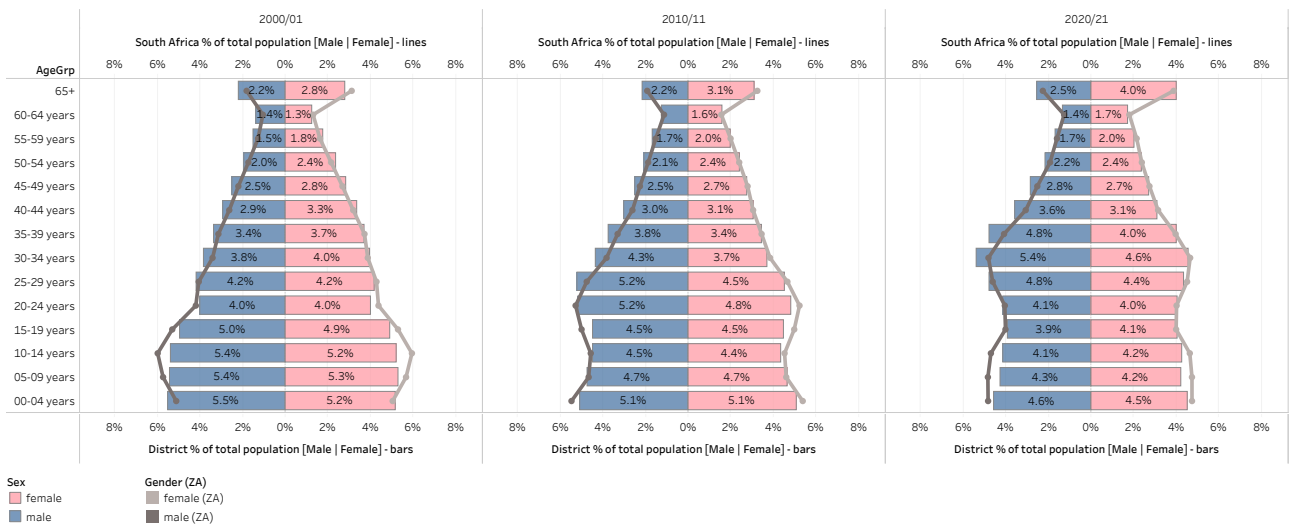

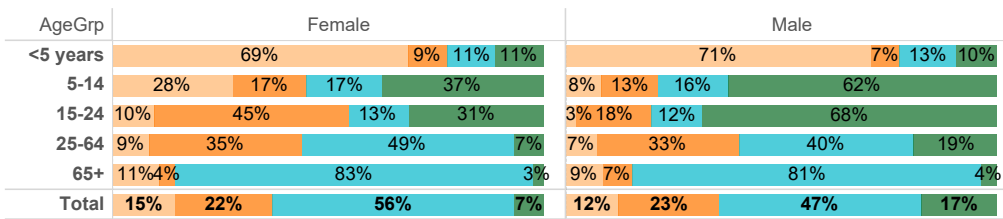

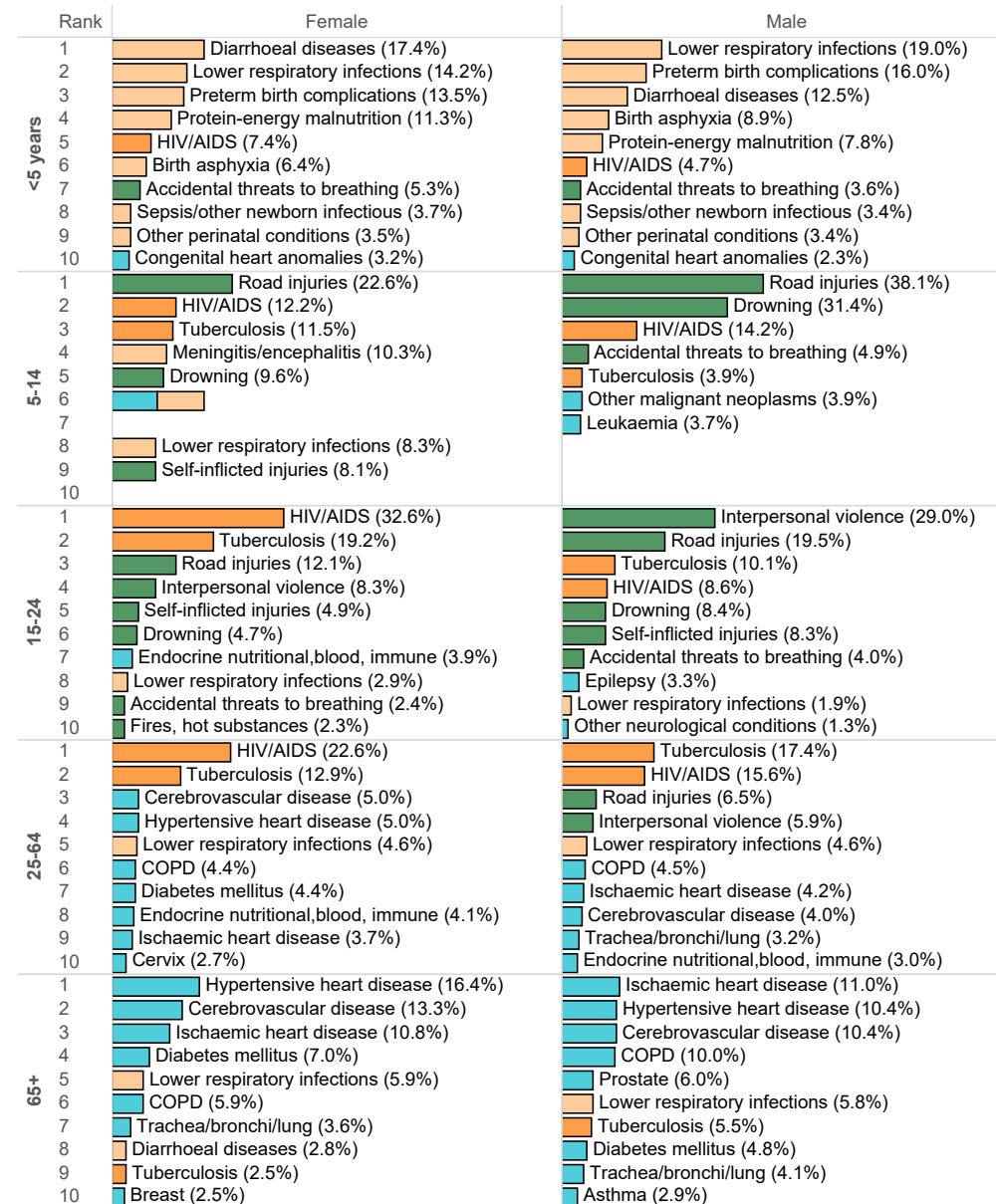

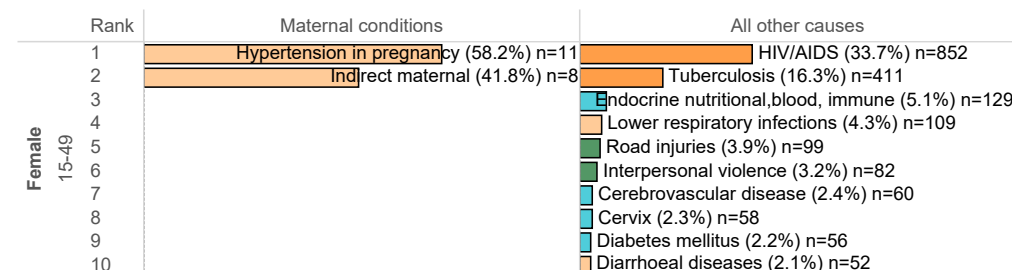
Percentage of deaths by broad causes and single leading causes



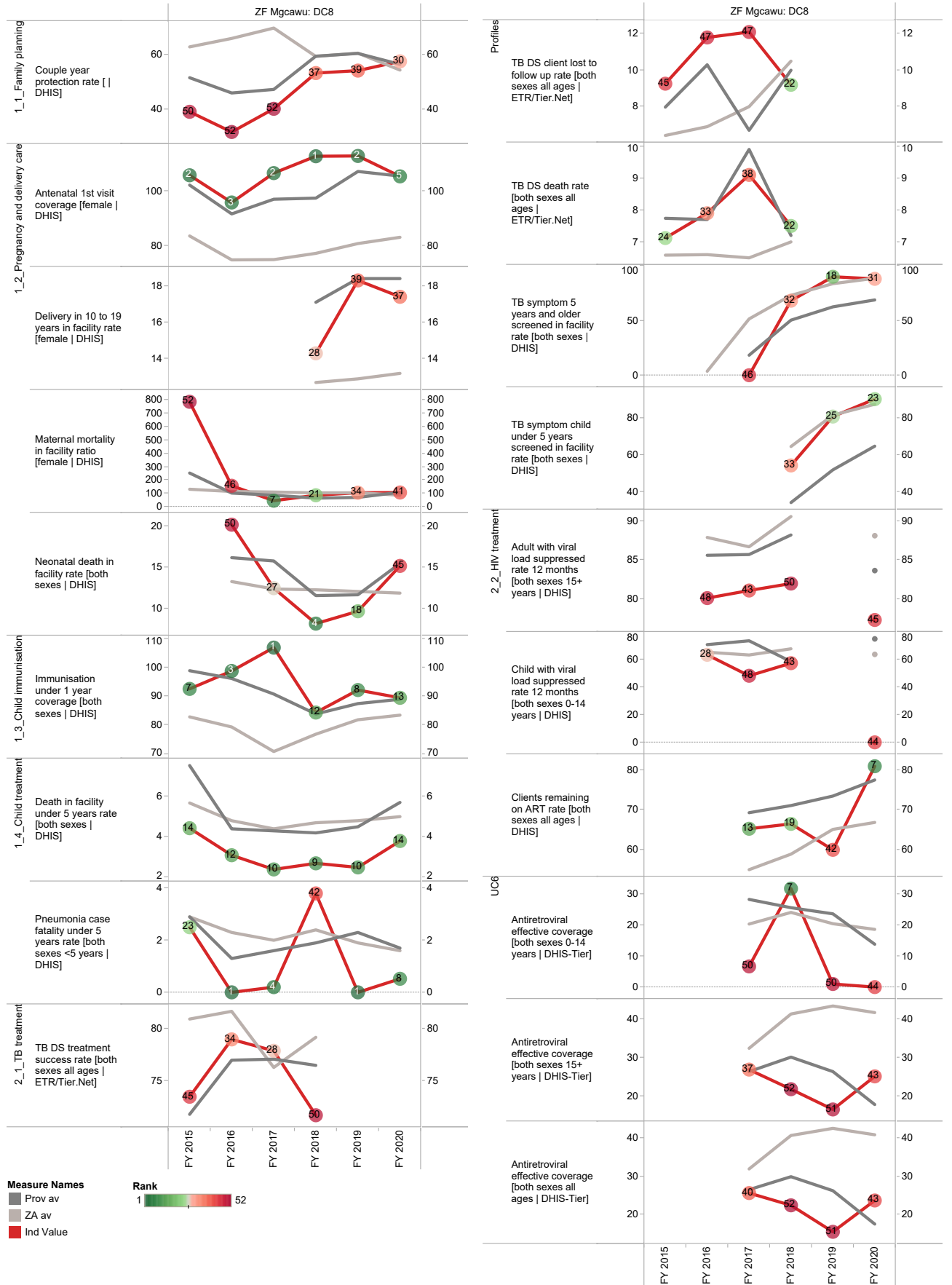

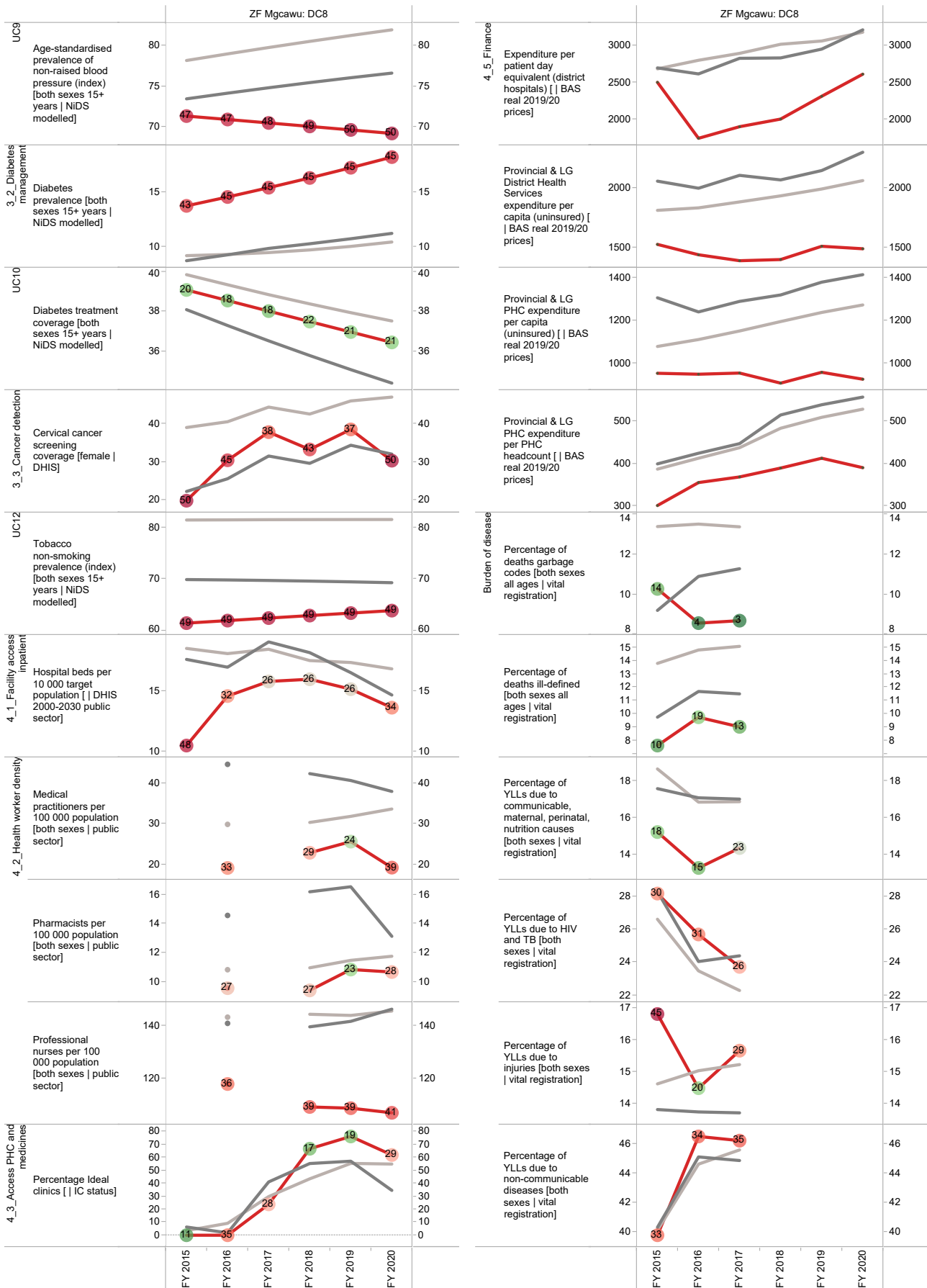

Frances Baard District Municipality (DC 9)

The municipality is the smallest district in the Northern Cape, making up only 3% of its geographical area. It comprises the four local municipalities of Dikgatlong, Magareng, Phokwane and Sol Plaatje.

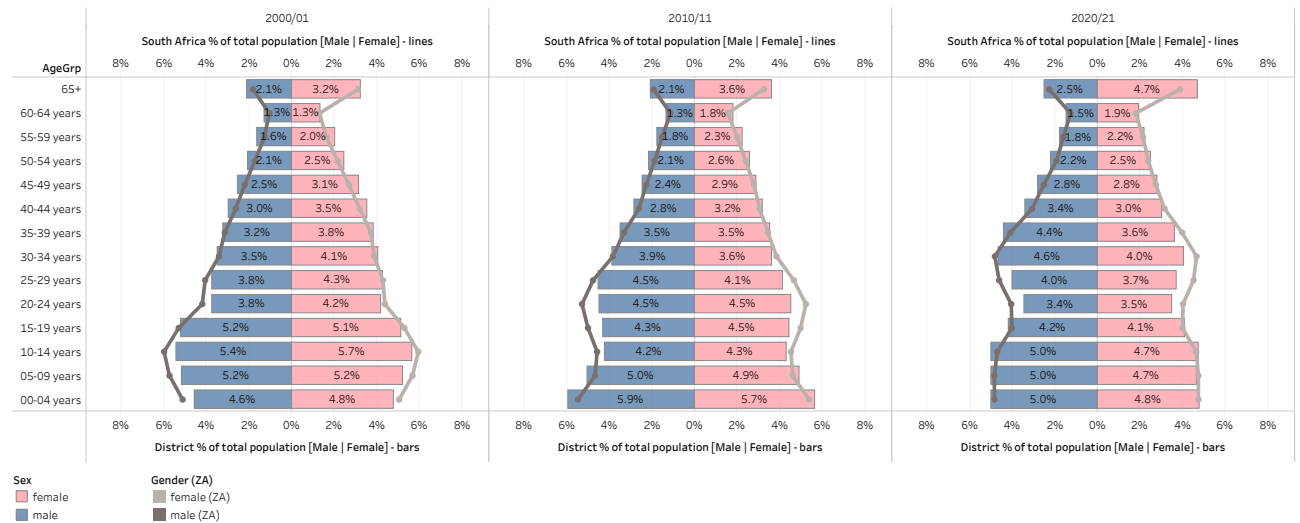

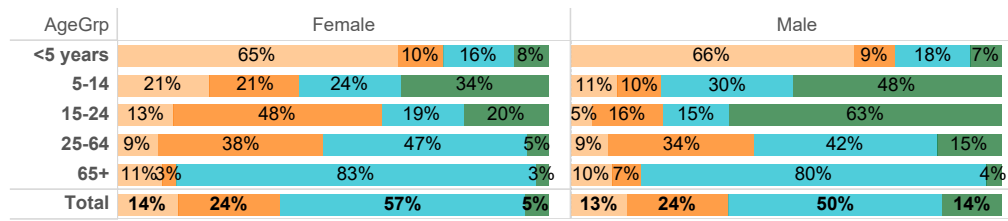

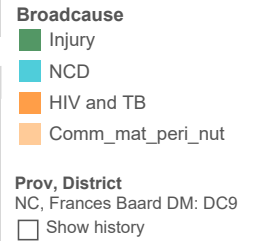

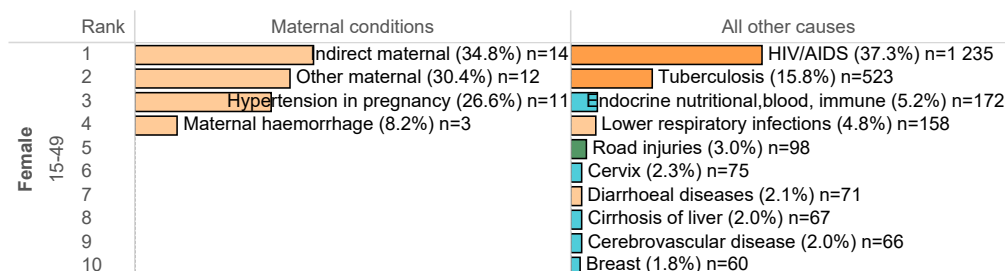
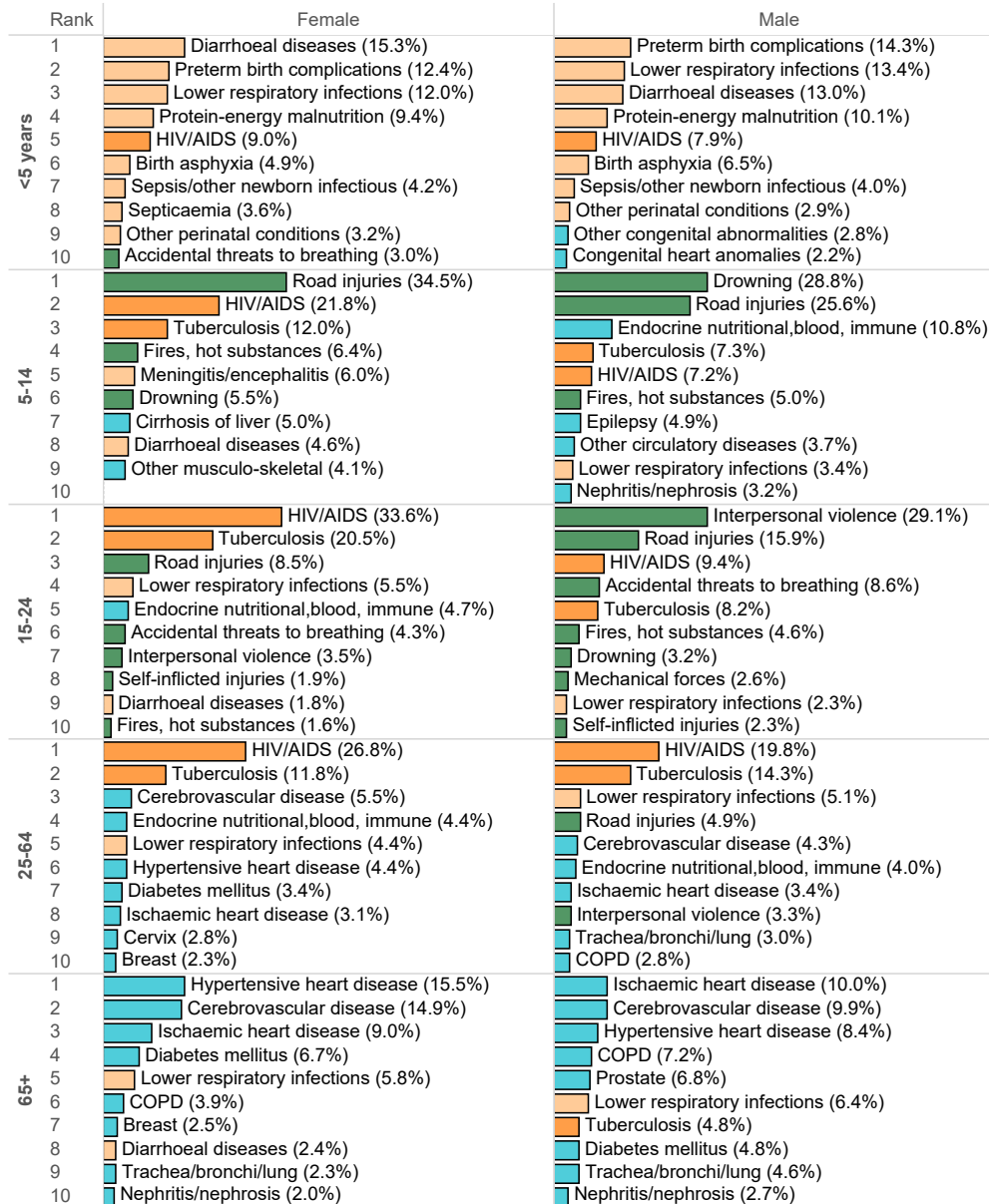
Percentage of deaths by broad cause and leading causes, 2012–2017

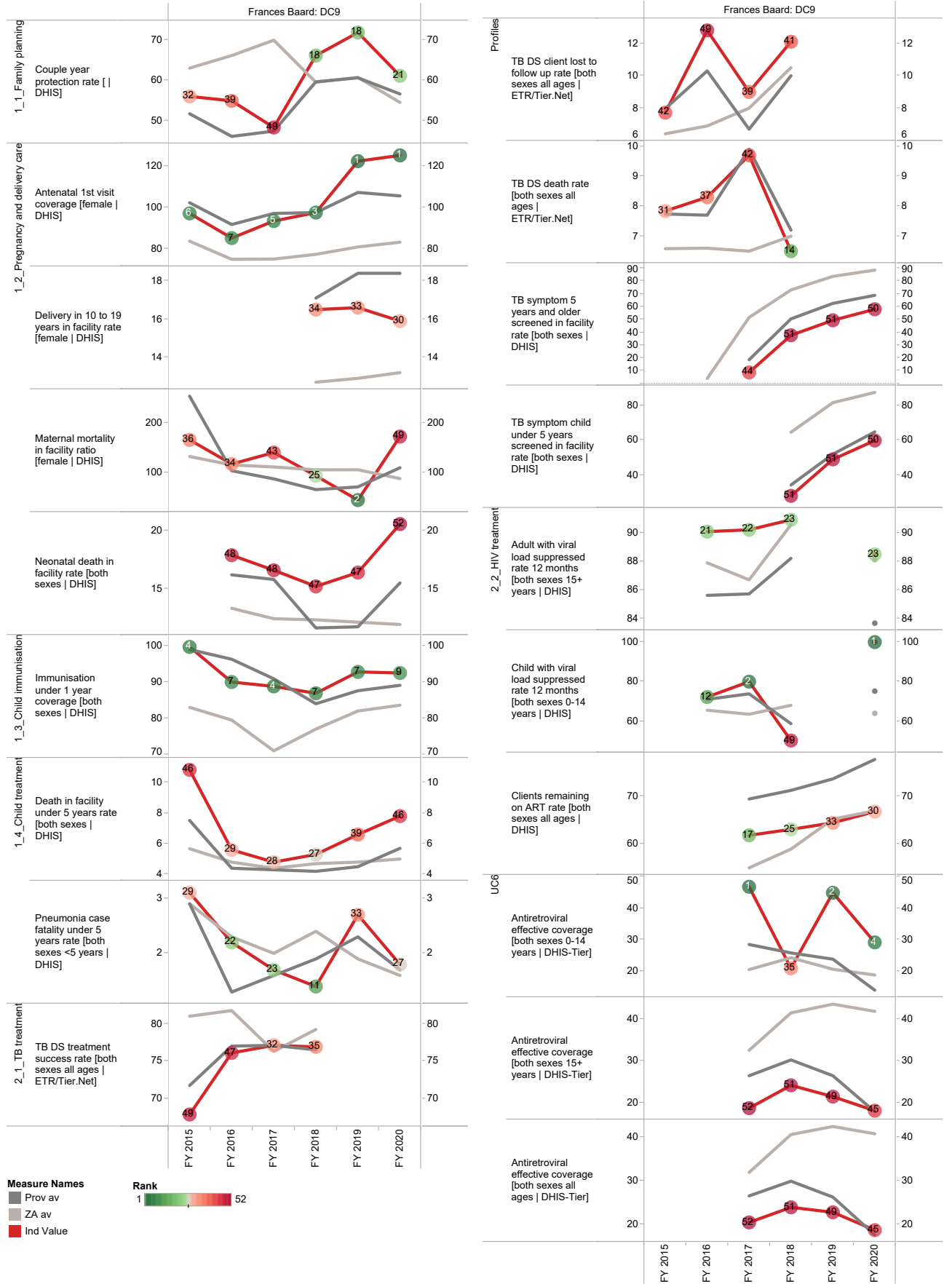
Percentage of deaths by broad causes and single leading causes
