

Interview protocol Key informant interviews

A key informant interview/discussion is conducted observing guidelines and principles of KII. Consent signed. A check needs to be done for language, even though the session will be facilitated in English. First language data to be gleaned from clinic record. Provision to be made for interpreter – perhaps a language proficient staff member.

KII protocol Introduction:

Short information on BP, risk and complication in pregnancy

The central question:

Please tell us what health information and messages related to blood pressure or your condition you received during your pregnancy that assisted you in preventing potential complications. (Notes and observation)

Probing questions

Where did you get the information from? (Source of information)?

Explain -

What health information did you receive from the antenatal care service (clinic)?-

What information was useful? -

Looking back what information would have helped you during the pregnancy with the high blood pressure? -
